

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
FEATHER RIVER GROVE, ADF

THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY CERTIFY THAT:

1. They are the president, secretary and treasurer, respectively, of Feather River Grove, ADF of Chico, California (hereinafter, the "Corporation").
2. The subsequent Articles of Incorporation has been duly approved by the Executive Committee.
3. The following subsequent Articles of Incorporation has been duly approved by the required vote of the members.
4. The Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation are to read as follows:

I.

The name of the Corporation is Feather River Grove, ADF (the "Corporation").

II.

This Corporation is a religious corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Religious Corporation Law exclusively for religious purposes, which shall include but not be limited to, providing regular opportunities for honoring the Kindred, prayer, teaching and studying Druidry, fellowship, environmental stewardship, and such other use of property and resources for educational, charitable, or civic purposes that, as discerned and directed by the Executive Committee, further the religious and spiritual mission of the Church.

This Corporation elects to be governed by all of the provisions of the Nonprofit Corporation Law not otherwise applicable to it under Part 5 of Division 2.

III.

The principal place of business of the Corporation shall be located within the State of California at 1009 Poppy Street, Chico, CA 95928, or such other place within the City of Chico in Butte County, State of California, as shall be determined by the Executive Committee.

IV.

The Corporation shall enjoy perpetual existence.

V.

The elected officers of the Executive Committee shall be its trustees and directors, and the number of individuals serving on the Executive Committee, and the manner in which they shall be elected, shall be set forth in the Bylaws.

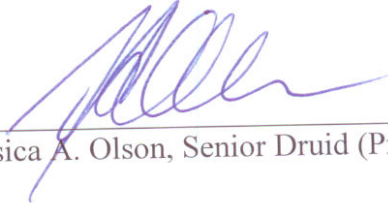
VI.


The Corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or a related section of a successor statute (hereinafter "Code"). No substantial part of the activities of this Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. The Corporation may receive property by gift, devise or bequest, invest and reinvest the same, and apply the income and principal thereof, as the Executive Committee may from time to time determine, either directly or through contributions to any charitable organization or organizations, exclusively for religious, charitable, or educational purposes. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Code or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

VII.

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, all assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the Corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code as determined by the Executive Committee. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of exclusively for such exempt purposes by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located.

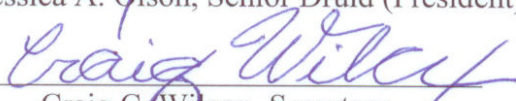

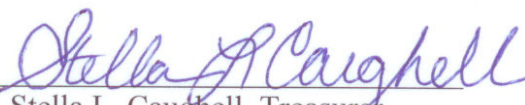
